Information About Bilecik



Bilecik is the provincial capital of Turkey's Bilecik Province. The population of the town is 62,320 (as of 2010). The town is famous for its numerous restored Turkish houses. It is increasingly becoming more attractive to tourists. With its rich architectural heritage, Bilecik is a member of the European Association of Historic Towns and Regions. 30 kilometers southeast from Bilecik is Söğüt, a small town, where the Ottoman Empire was founded in 1299. Bilecik has a Mediterranean climate near the borderline of the continental climate with cold and often snowy winters and hot and dry summers. Summers are hot and dry with temperatures usually exceeding 30°C in the height of summer, they are also the driest months. Winters are cold and it frequently snows a lot between the months of December and March.

Founded in the lands which hosted many civilizations; most importantly Ottoman Empire; Bilecik Şeyh Edebali University looks back on a 600 hundred years tradition. Physically, Bilecik Şeyh Edebali University has a wide campus that is growing daily where students can make use of the facilities to meet their cultural and daily needs. 1 **Transportation**

Arriving to Bilecik from İstanbul has different options. Visitors may take train from İstanbul to Bilecik which takes 4 hours. Visitors may also come to Bilecik from İstanbul by bus which also takes 4 hours (appr.) Domestic airline which is half an hour away from Bilecik gives service to many cities in Turkey. Local transportation, from school to downtown, to the hostels and dormitories are provided by minibuses.



2 Accommodation

Accommodation in Bilecik is quite reasonable for incoming visitors. A government dormitory next to the campus is available to visitors during the orientation period, while private hostels also provide service. Students also may rent houses.

- Foreigners living in Turkey T.C. They can go to the state hospital and be examined. In order for foreigners to be examined at the State Hospital, they must have a residence permit identification number. Examination or medical report fees are lower for those who have a residence permit. No fee is charged for foreigners who are examined in Emergency Policlinics. Foreign nationals are required to make an appointment in order to be examined from hospitals. In case of any emergency, you can enter the hospital from the emergency department. Those with a residence permit can make appointments via the Alo 182 or MHRS system.

Foreign National Patients with Residence Permit

- Patients with a residence permit who work or trade in a foreign country are required to obtain an identification number starting with nine (9) from the Social Security Institution. For patients who are registered by the social security institution and apply to our hospital for examination, a check is made on whether they can benefit from health services over the internet. If the patient can benefit from health services as a result of the control, the examination record is opened. Foreign nationals with a residence permit must apply to the hospital with a passport with the identity number issued by the Social Security Institution. When applying to the emergency service of our hospital, the necessary emergency examination of the patient is provided with priority, regardless of the patient's social security. After the treatment of the patient is over, the necessary documents are requested from the patient or his relatives.

The information you have entered must match your information in the Population Directorate. Otherwise, you will not be able to complete your subscription process.

Inner City (Local) and Inter-City Passenger Transportation

- Bilecik is one of the most important historical destinations of Turkey where Ottoman Empire was founded by Osman Gazi in 1299. It is the land where the course of history changed with the conquest of Belekoma Castle and Yarhisar in 1299 by Osman Bey. The city is one of the smallest cities of the country in terms of surface area and located in Marmara Region. Marble and ceramic processing has a special place in Bilecik's economy. In addition to the marble quarries, which contribute significantly to the economy, feldspar reserves, which are used as raw materials in ceramic and glass making, are also very rich. In addition, clay and kaolin are also mined. Turkey is one of the world's richest countries in terms of marble reserves in Bilecik and has an important place in this market. The city's proximity to important port cities such as İstanbul and İzmir and the ease of transportation also provided a great advantage in the growth of the sector.

In our university, mid-term, end-of-semester, make-up, excuse, level determination and single course exams are held.

Evaluation:

Student success; It is determined by evaluating the level of success in midterm exams, homework, practice, laboratory and similar studies done during the semester, and the results of the final exam and make-up exam.

The total weight of the midterm evaluations of a course (midterm exam, quiz, homework and practice) is determined by the lecturer in the first two weeks of the semester, provided that it is not less than 30% and not more than 60%.

Grading:

For each course students take, one of the following letter grades is given by the instructor as the end-of-term course grade. The coefficients of the letter grades and their equivalents out of 100 points are shown below

The following notes are used in other assessments:

- a) DZ grade: It is given to students who do not fulfill their attendance requirements. It is treated like an FF grade in the GPA calculation. The student repeats the course for which he received a DZ grade.
- b) İZ grade: It is given to students who do not fulfill their attendance requirements or course application requirements because they are on academic leave and are not included in their grade point average. The student repeats the course for which he received the İZ grade.
- c) YT grade: It is given to the student who is successful in the courses that are not included in the grade point average.
- ç) YZ grade: It is given to students who fail the courses that are not included in the grade point average.
- d) GM grade: It is given to the exams that the student has not taken. If a student who gets a GM grade in the mid-term exams takes the mid-term make-up exam, the GM grade is converted to a numerical grade. If he does not take the make-up exam during the semester, the GM grade is converted to zero (0). The grade obtained at the end of the make-up exam is evaluated together with the semester grades as the final exam grade and converted into a success grade according to the student's place in the class final grade. The GM grade of the students who do not participate in the make-up exam is accepted as zero (0) and converted into a final grade according to the student's place in the class final grade.
- e) SD grade: The courses that the student is not responsible for are given an SD grade and are not included in the average. Shown in the transcript; but the grade is not shown in the status sheet.

Last points about evaluation

Course Repetition:

Students must first take the courses in the lower semester with FF, YZ and DZ grades or the courses they have not taken at all, except for the courses that they cannot meet the prerequisite. When the failed courses are taken again, the last grade obtained is included in the GPA calculation. In order to increase the overall grade point average,

he/she can repeat the courses he/she has been successful in before, and the last grade obtained is included in the calculation of the grade point average.

Success Evaluation:

In order for students to be successful, their GPA must be at least 2.00. Students who cannot provide the specified GPA are considered unsuccessful. According to the success evaluation directive, students are determined as honour and high honour students.

Thesis Advisor;

- (1) Guides the student in determining an original thesis topic and problematizing his thesis and writing his thesis proposal.
- (2) Supervises the student's writing during the thesis writing process, and gives feedback to the student about their writing by making regular interviews.
- (3) Makes the necessary inspections for the thesis to be written in accordance with the ethical rules and the thesis writing guide.
- (4) In theses for which research permission is required, it guides the student through the process of writing an article explaining the data collection tools and directs the student to apply to the institute by filling out the aforementioned article, thesis proposal and related forms in order to obtain research permission from the relevant institution.
- (5) In theses for which ethics committee approval is required, it guides the student in writing an article explaining his research and

directs the student to apply to the institute by filling out the article, thesis proposal and related forms in order to apply to the ethics committee.

(6) In the change of thesis title, he/she fills in the relevant forms together with the student, approves the forms, and warns the student to submit the forms to the Graduate School.

(7) Guides the student to prepare a new thesis proposal in the change of thesis topic, approves the relevant forms and warns the student to submit the forms to the Graduate School.

(8) By following the maximum duration of the student, it ensures that the thesis monitoring and defense committees of the student meet regularly.

(9) Before the thesis defense, he/she receives the “plagiarism report” and approves it.

(10) Makes suggestions for the Department/Major Art Branch to determine the student’s “thesis monitoring” and “thesis defense” juries.

(11) Approves the student’s thesis defense.

Bilecik is the host of Sheikh Edebali Mausoleum, and also it is well-known for marble industry, ceramics, cherries, grapes, figs, watermelon, quinces, pomegranates, bozo, silk capsule, handcraft, earthenware, highlands, plateau, promenade, the monument of Metrastepe.

• **HISTORY**

- The first known names are Agrilion and Belekoma.
- The first settlement in Bilecik started during the transition period to the Bronze Age in Anatolia.
- The ancient city of Agrilion is located in the 4 km southwest of the present city. Its history dates back to 3000 BC.
- It is also known that tin was mined for bronze making in Bilecik before Christ.
- Bilecik was ruled very long time by the Romans. • It was known as Belekoma in the Eastern Roman period.
- There was a castle known as Belekoma during the Byzantine period between the Hamsu and Debağhane streams of today's settlement.
- Bilecik, which was located at the edge of the Byzantine struggle with the Seljuks in the 13th century.
- Under the Byzantine rule Bilecik was governed semi-independently from

the center under the administration of tekfur since the middle of the century.

- Bilecik is the lands where the Ottoman Empire was born.
- Bilecik joined the Ottoman lands with a sudden raid in 1299.
- After the capture of Bilecik, The founder of Ottoman Empire, Osman Gazi had built a mosque in Bilecik,
- His young son Ali and his wife, Sheikh Edebali, who was also his wife's father, lived here.
- Every year, the Commemoration of Ertuğrul Gazi and Söğüt festivals are held in Söğüt, a province of Bilecik.
- In the years of Turkish war of independence Bilecik underwent a great wreckage with great destructions.
- After driving away the Greeks by first rebellions against the enemy and with the leadership of the great leader Mustafa Kemal Atatürk on September 6th 1922, it became province of Bilecik in 1924 and started to become a modern city of the young Turkish Republic.
- Geographical location
- Bilecik province is located in the southeast of the Marmara Region; It is located on the cutting points of the Marmara, Black Sea, Central Anatolian Region and Aegean Regions.



Climate

- Total annual precipitation is around 450 kg/m².
- Precipitation falls mostly in January and May.
- Annual average temperature: 12.3 °C
- The Coldest month: January (2.5 °C)
- The Hottest month: July (21.7 °C)
- Annual average relative humidity: 66% Population and Districts



- The city center is 95 km from the Bilecik border. It is 80 km from Eskişehir, 250 km from Istanbul and 110 km from Kütahya.
- According to 2017 data the population of Bilecik is 221,963.
- Bilecik's surface area is 4,310 km² and there are 51 people per square kilometer. In other words, the population density of the city is 51/km².
- The most populated districts of Bilecik are Merkez and Bozüyük. Other districts are; Osmaneli, Söğüt, Gölpaazarı, Pazaryeri, Yenişehir and İnhisar.
- In terms of population, the center is the most crowded, and İnhisar is the least crowded districts.

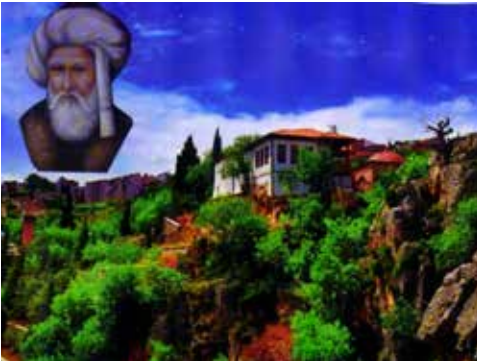
Ertuğrul Gazi Mausoleum

- The district of Söğüt has a historical importance as the place where the Ottoman Empire was founded and the first capital.
- ERTUGRUL GAZI MAUSOLEUM(SÖĞÜT)
- In addition, the fact that the tomb of Ertuğrul Gazi is in this district ensures that thousands of visitors come every year. In other words it is the most popular places to visit in Bilecik
- It is located on the way of Bilecik. The construction date is unknown. First, it was built as a shrine by commandation of Osman Ghozi and then was renovated as mausoleum by Celebi Mehmet.



Şeyh Edebali Mausoleum

Sheikh Edebali (1206–1326) sheikh of Ahi, is a spiritual founder of Ottoman Empire and 'Osman Gazi's father in law. His Mausoleum was constructed by Orhan Gazi at the beginning of 14th century. It is located on a hill where old Bilecik was constructed. It has one saloon and two rooms. The big room with altar was used as a mosque, Another room was used for guests and meetings. There are his daughter's and Bala Hatun's ('Osman gazi's wife) Mausoleums at the eastern part of the Sheikh Edebali's Mausoleum.



Orhan Gazi Mosque

Orhan Gazi Mosque was built in 1339 by the second Ottoman ruler, Orhan Bey. This building was repaired in 1417 by Bayezid Pasha. Orhan Gazi Mosque contains a porch with five bays on the north. A domed vestibule is placed between the porch and the main prayer hall. This latter part is a rectangular area topped by a dome.

Osman Gazi Mosque

It is located in the Northwest of old Bilecik, in the middle of a small valley. It was built to the name of Osman Ghazi by commendation of Orhan Ghazi. The North wall and the entrance wall of the mosque are standing after Greek invasion.

The Tower Clock

The Tower Clock is located at the center of Bilecik province over a dominant hill to the city. The Tower Clock is four sided, with one clock in each side and was constructed by Sultan II. Abdulhamit.



Ertuğrul Gazi Small Mosque

It is located in the southwest of Bilecik. It was built in 1276 by the commendation of Ertuğrul Ghazi.



Hamidiye Mosque (Söğüt)

It is also called as 'Couple Domed Mosque' It was constructed in 1889 by Sultan II. Abdulhamid.



Dursun Fakih Shrine (Küre- Sögüt)

It is located 16 kms away from Sögüt in Küre village. Dursun Fakih was the son in law of Sheikh Edeballi. The last restoration of the tomb was in 2013.

Kaymakam Fontain (Sögüt)

It is located near the park in front of Celebi Mehmet Mosque. The importance of this fountain is to reflect the last period of Ottoman architecture. It was constructed at the end of the nineteenth century by Kaymakam Sait.



Çelebi Mehmet Mosque

It is located opposite the House of the Government in Söğüt. It was constructed by the commandation of Sultan Çelebi Mehmet in fourteenth century. It was renovated in nineteenth century.



Bilecik Museum

it was constructed as a prison in 1920s but then restored and has been used as a museum since 2006.



Ethnography Museum (Söğüt)

It is located in Söğüt. Authentic Tents belonging to Oğuz Turks and carpets,rugs, weapons, clothes pottery, monuments are exhibited in.



Inönü Martyrdom (Bozüyük)

It is located 6 km away from the town. Martyrdom in which has been surrounded by pine trees and fir trees has marble token .Every year in 7 April Inonu Martyrs's Commemoration is held here.



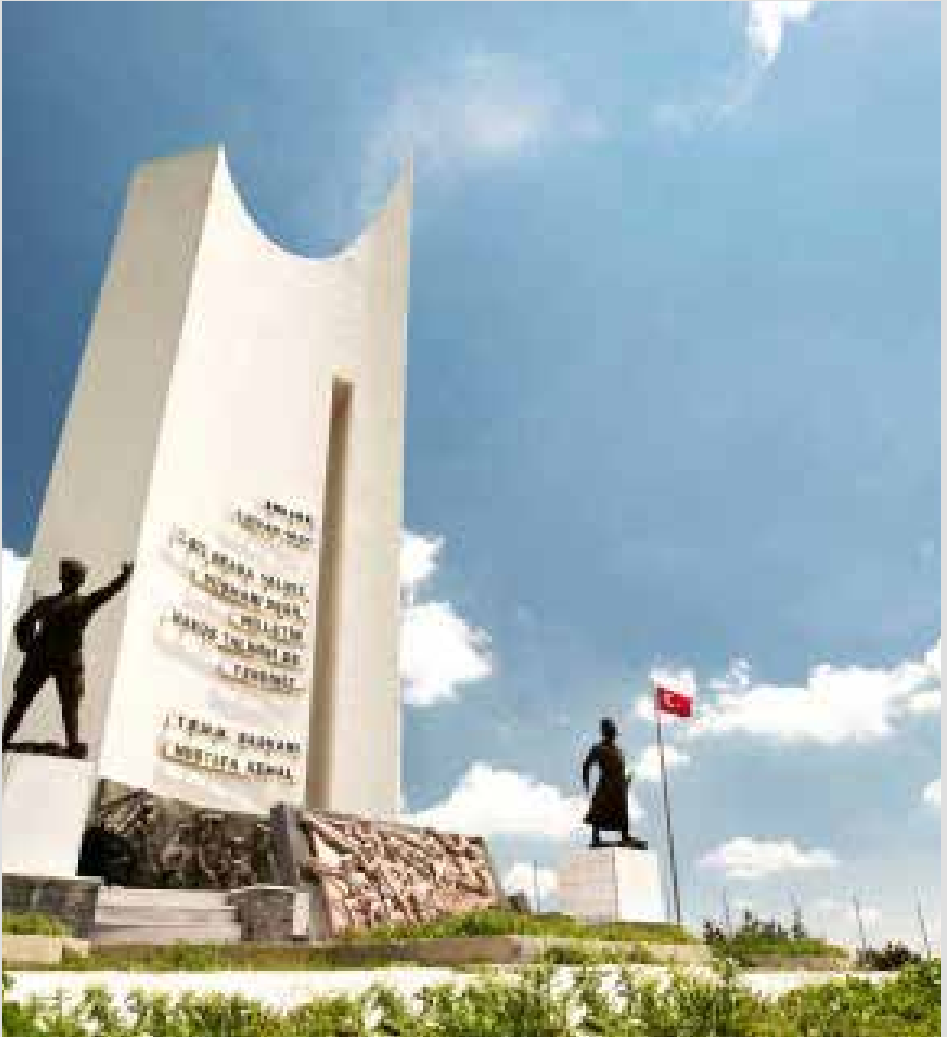
İntikamtepe Martyrdom (Bilecik)

It is located on the way of Bozüyük–Dodurga. The graves belong to our Martyrs of Turkish Independence War.



The Monument of Metristepe

Inonu wars were won on Metris Hill and Atatürk sent telegraph to Ismet Inonu and said “You defeated not only enemy but also Turkish nation’s bad fortune there” This monument which was constructed to keep our martyrs’ memory alive . It is on the left of Bozuyuk-Eskisehir motorway and 12 kms away from the main road. it can be reached from both Bozüyük and Söğüt.



National Parks and Natural Wonders

Küçükemalı National Park (Pazaryeri)

It is located in the borders of Küçükemalı village, which is 10 kilometers away from Pazaryeri district. The area is covered with pine forests. There are tennis courts, basketball and volleyball fields, jogging parkours, playgrounds park for children.



Pelitözü Pond-Promenade (Bilecik)

This pond consists of 213,50 acres of area. It was constructed for watering the fields. Recently it is being reconstructed as a center of attraction with its walking paths, wooden cafe's, children's playground, the windmill, unique ottoman tent. It is easy to access and close to the city center. It is 7 km far from Bilecik city center. There are pine trees around the lake. Usually it is visited at the weekends. There are picnic areas around the Lake Pelitözü. Hiking or camping can also be done.



Turbin Picnic Area (Bozüyük)

This promenade area is located at 7 km. away from BOZUYUK District. With its waterfall, the promenade area is an interesting and preferred area. There are restaurants, parks for children.



The Harmankaya Kanyonu (Yenipazar)

This canyon is approximately 3 km long and is an attraction point for those who like trekking.



The City Forest (Bilecik)

It is 2 km away from the city centre and on the way to Eskişehir. It has been prepared as an excursion field in the forest and called as Atatürk Forest by the Ministry of Forestry. It has clean air, nice landscape its near to the city centre.

AGRICULTURE

- Major agricultural products include wheat, legumes, barley, corn, chickpeas, beans, sugar beets, sunflowers, onions, kidney beans, purslane, carrots, green peppers, tomatoes, eggplant, lettuce, salad and hops. In addition, greenhouse cultivation is carried out within the scope of agricultural activities in Bilecik, which is also famous for grapes, pomegranates, plums, quinces and cherries.

Nightlife

- Bilecik is a small city, it does not have an active nightlife.
- However, there are restaurants and cafes. Bilecik's famous park, Selale Park, is open until 01:00.
